Sub:	SWD – JVD Schemes – Filing of Fresh applications in college login by the Principals for 2020-21 academic year – Last date is fixed as March 20, 2021 – Instructions – Issued - Regarding.
Ref:	1. Circular D2/2439/2019 dated 21-12-2020 of the DSW 2. Schedule for release of JVD schemes for 2020-21 in April, 2021

Government announced schedule for release of first instalment of Jagananna Vasathi Deevena and Jagananna Vidya Deena for 2020-21 in April 2021.

Hence, there is need to ensure that applications of all eligible students are fully processed and kept ready for release of JVD benefits by the first week of April.

To be ready for this schedule of release of JVD benefits, all colleges shall complete filing of fresh applications soon, so that the process of verification of eligibility of applications can be started. In case of ineligible applications, they need to be given opportunity to file objections, if any, and they shall be disposed off. This process requires atleast 15 days.

Already instructions are issued vide reference first cited that the last date for filing of fresh applications is 20 days from the date of admission of the student in the college.

It is observed that admissions in all types of courses are completed weeks ago for the academic year 2020-21.

Hence, in view of all the above mentioned factors, it is decided to keep March 20, 2021 as the last date for filing of fresh applications for 2020-21.

All Principals are requested to ensure that they complete the filing of fresh applications of the students by March 20, 2021 without fail in their login in Jnanabhumi portal.

There is no hurdle to file the applications in the college login, even though the affiliation of the college/institution is not yet approved by the concerned regulatory body for 2020-21. Releases for fresh students will be stopped in April, in case affiliation is not approved by then, but filing of fresh applications is not prevented in the college login on account of pendency of affiliation approval.

In case any college/institution fails to apply within stipulated time for any eligible student for the JVD schemes, then it will be treated as lapse on the part of the college, and the fee for such student shall be waived by the college and the student shall not be required to pay the fee, as the student is deprived by the college of getting the benefit of JVD schemes from the government, by not filing the application within prescribed time-limit.
